Express your gratitude for the blessings, experiences or impressions you have in your daily walk with God. You can tell of those moments at places when you suddenly knew or felt that you truly belonged to God. You can write about happiness, love and adoration, devotion, hope and sincerity.

You may also want to write about what you saw in the lives of those close to you (with their consent of course!) that fill you/them with gratitude. Please use discretion when writing about others.

General Information

Write an essay of 200 words (excluding the Bible verse) on the theme of Gratitude (see explanation under theme). Please, no sermons.

Do not quote your Bible verse, just mention the Book, chapter and verse you want to add to your essay, e.g. John 3:15.

Each of your contributions must have a different Bible verse, but we may have to change it if it is used by too many different contributors.

To qualify for a contributor's discount of 50%, you need to submit at least five (5) contributions. If you send in less than five (5), you will only qualify for a contributor's discount of 20%. Editor's discretion must be respected and accepted.

This book will be marketed outside the Seventh-day Adventist Church as well as within the church; therefore, non-specific terminology should be used so as not to offend those of any religious persuasion. We encourage global participation, with a varied cultural and ethnic flavour.

Those who contribute to this project do so agreeing that all profits from the royalties of the devotional books will go to the Southern Africa Women's Ministries Scholarship Fund.

They further agree that they will receive no payment for any contributions submitted or accepted for publication.
